Dear Renewable Energy Incentive Program (REIP) Applicant:

Re: Certification Needed to Fulfill Application Requirements for REIP Incentive Approval

The REIP provides New Jersey ratepayers with incentives that cover a portion of the cost of a renewable energy system. To ensure that the anticipated benefits generated by these systems are realized by the citizens of New Jersey, the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities has directed the Office of Clean Energy to modify REIP procedures. As a condition of incentive commitment approval, every applicant must provide written certification for inclusion in their REIP application package an agreement by the customer, that if he or she sells or otherwise transfers the equipment for which incentives were paid to any party for use outside of New Jersey, the customer will refund back to the State a pro-rata share of the incentive received. This obligation will last for 10 years, beginning on the date of receipt of the REIP incentive. The customer and vendor must also submit the attached amendment to the contract for installed equipment on file with the REIP program, signed by both parties, acknowledging the customer's awareness of this obligation as a condition of the incentive.
